We had a well visit and 3 days later,, we were back in his office, where I was told I had to go immediately to the hospital. We were there for a week and Dr Hirsch either came in himself or called me on the phone to see how I was doing, he already knew how my son was. We started out in his office every 3 days, my kids alternated being sick, and soon got to every 8, and then longer and longer.. About 2 yrs later we moved to Manalapan, and Dr Hirsch happened to live down the block from me. When the kids were really sick and he was really busy, he would ask us to just meet him at his house.. Dr Hirsch would call me, to check in with me, not always to see how my kids were doing, but how I was doing.. We continued with Dr Hirsch until my son was going away to college. It was sometime after that, that I believe he moved to Lakewood again. I have often thought about him, he will forever be a part of my heart.. Reading the messages here, we can all tell that we were not special, it was Harvey who was so special, allowing us moms and dads to have him with us in some really hard times.
