*My mother, Mildred Robins Seltzer, 83, of Lakewood, NJ, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, June 13, 2018, at Ocean Medical Center in Brick, NJ. She was with her children as she passed.*

*Mildred was born in Philadelphia in 1934 to her parents Morris and Anna Robins. She had an older brother Benjamin (Bernie) and an older sister Eileen. She graduated from Girls High School and Temple University, with a teaching degree. On June 27, 1954 she married Dr. Sol Seltzer, also of South Philadelphia. They were married for 53 years, until his death in 2007. They were introduced by her friend, Sol's cousin Miriam Brown Weinbaum.*

*After the birth of their first child Michelle, Dr. and Mrs. Seltzer moved briefly to Texas for his service in the US Army. After a period in Baltimore, where their daughter Sharon was born, they moved in 1960 to Brick, NJ, where Dr. Seltzer established a medical practice. Two sons, Michael and Larry, were born to them in Brick. Mrs. Seltzer dedicated herself to raising her children and assisting in the administration of her husband's medical practice. The Seltzers sent their children for a religious education in neighboring Lakewood and became attached to that community. In 1985 they moved to 7th street and became a fixture in the Lakewood Jewish community.*

*Mrs. Seltzer is survived by her four children, nine grandchildren, one great-grandchild and many good friends in Lakewood and beyond.*
