I remember he had 2 older brothers studying to be Rabbis I think. They would be walking around the dining room table, chanting in Hebrew (aloud) and wearing white robes & "yamakes\_.

Moshe was very smart and was one of Kay Kysers Whiz Kids on the radio. His parents would drive him to New York every week for the radio broadcast.

I moved to Texas later that year and we would write, he told me I was his 6th favorite girl friend. I was so thrilled. Hoped to move up eventually.

He was really cute and when I got a computer so many years later I looked for him. Always wondered what he had become. A Rabbi. How wonderful. And I thought of calling many times just to say hi, but it had been so many years. I was 80 that year so I guess he would have also been 80.

I know his parent were proud of him. I looked up a photo of him in which he was probably in his early twenties and I would have recognized him then. And I looked up a photo of him way later with full beard and could still recognize him because of that smile and glint in his eyes.
